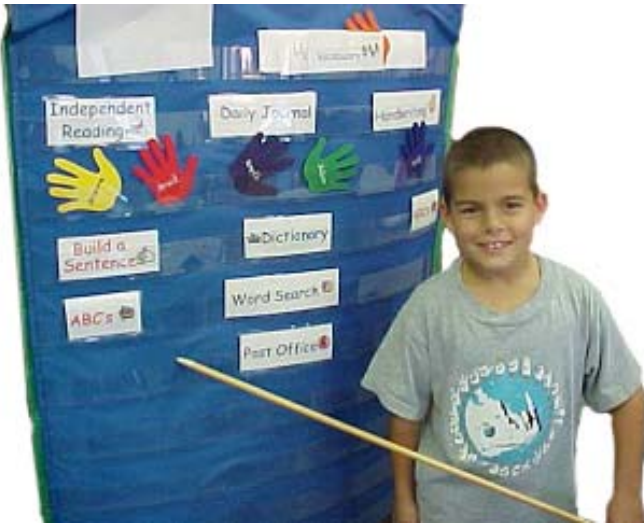

Community Advisory Council



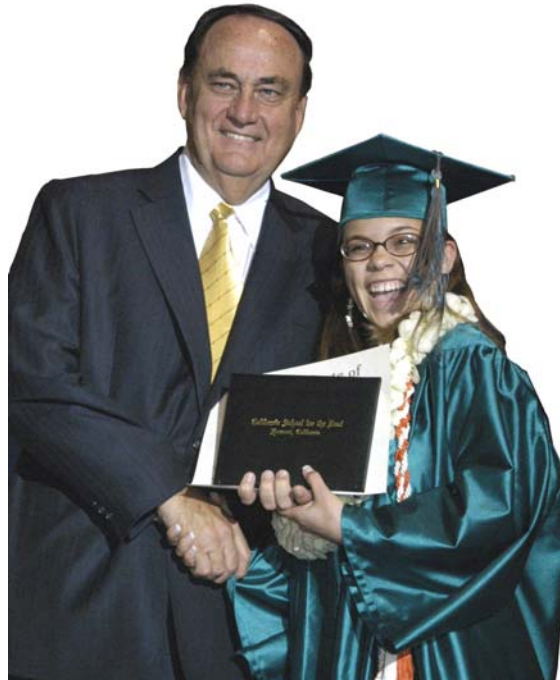
What is CAC?

CAC is an advisory council to assist the California School for the Deaf in bringing about the cooperation and coordination of community resources within the geographical area served by the school.

The council was originally created in 1978, at the suggestion of California School for the Deaf parents, from Sacramento.

The council was established because of the California School for the Deaf's commitment to parent involvement.

The California School for the Deaf is the first state special school to create a CAC. The school serves as a model for other state schools nationwide.
