1. Bring: Student and Parent Social Security #s

(Alien Registration #s if you are not a U.S. citizen)

- If you don't have either, you may be eligible for the CA DREAM Act App and scholarships.
- 2. Bring: 2018 Federal tax forms like 1040, W-2, bank statements, etc.

You will not have to reveal this information to anyone, but you will need it to complete the forms. If your family does not file taxes and or receives public assistance, pleas ebring those statements.

3. Check in with your Career Center about sending your Cal Grant GPA to the California Student Aid Commission.
