DIPLOMA/CERTIFICATE DISTRIBUTION

On Graduation Day, graduates will receive a generic document that will temporarily stand in for their diploma/certificate. Soon after graduation, diplomas/certificates will be mailed home. To avoid delays, graduates need to return all loaned materials from CSD including textbooks, library books, electronic devices etc. All debts must also be cleared. Frank Lester will work closely with students and families to ensure all materials are returned and debts are cleared.
